## Mid-Late Winter Marching Orders

Many online nursery retailers and big box stores have started with their early rounds of seed/seed-starting supplies, as well as gardening accessories and systems. We've listed a few current deals in this newsletter (see left). To get the best results possible with your selections, [visit our Sowing Seeds page](#).

Now is also a good time to swoop in and purchase clearance deals on pots/planters. I found great deals for a variety of food-safe plastic pots, ranging from 2-3 gallon pots (11-13 inches) for \$4-\$6, to 5-7 gallon pots (14-17 inches) for \$5-\$15 at Lowe's and Ace Hardware. We often shop Bloem brand, which offers self-watering options.

**\*The secret is to "window-shop" frequently, across multiple websites and/or locations before purchasing. Being flexible on color choices can also save you quite a bit of savings.** See the links below for planning your garden arrangement and selecting the appropriate planters.

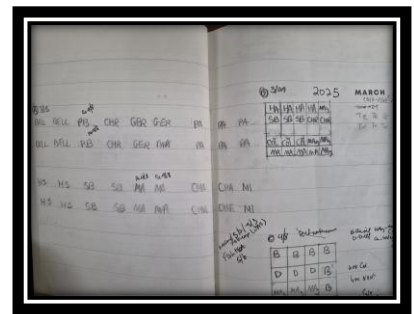
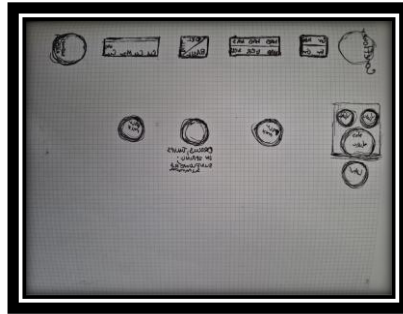
## Creating Your Garden Plan:

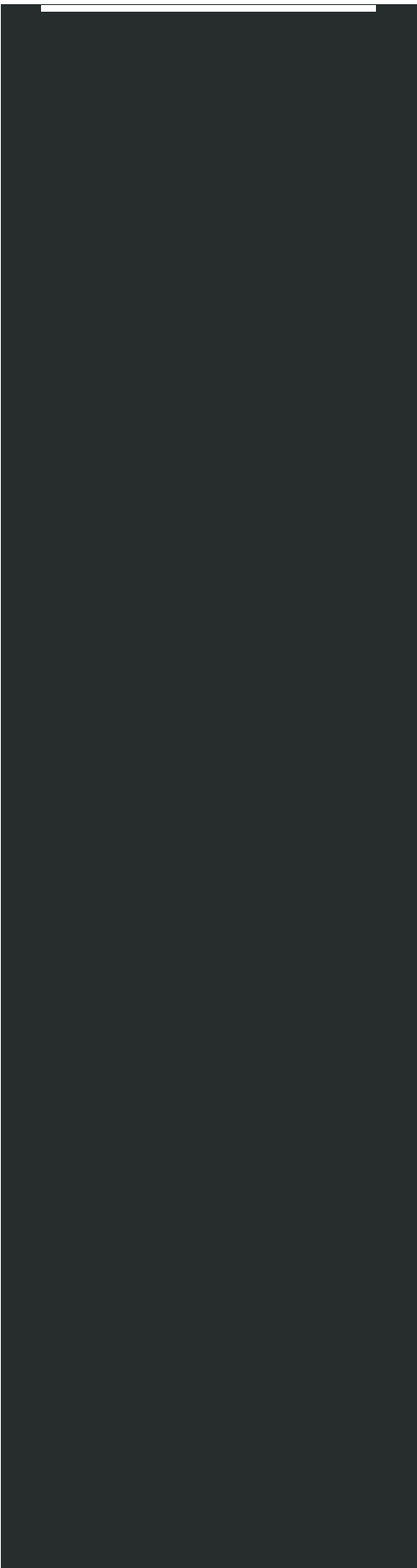
*L: A rough rendering for GG 2024 garden, R: 2025 Seed-starting layout with dates and notes*

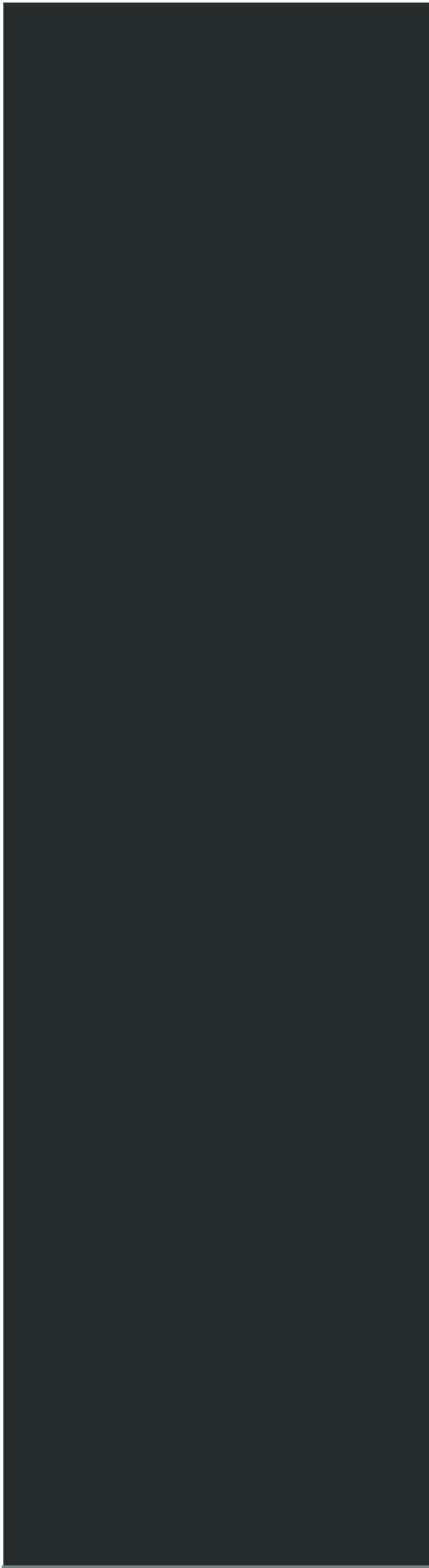
